Fixing From Below

If fixing your Sumo from below your mounting surface follow: A

The mounting surface must not be thicker than **25mm or 1"** for this option.



If fixing your Sumo from above your mounting surface follow: B

Screws must be no shorter than **30mm or 1 1/4"** for this option. *(screws not supplied)






Ensure that you follow the correct section for your chosen mounting configuration.






The mounting surface must not be thicker than **25mm or 1"** for this option.






If your Sumo Stalk Base Rotation is configured to off, follow steps (4) + (4). Mark out the positions for the Mounting Holes. Please note that your chosen rotate configuration will determine the minimum distance you can mount Sumo from a wall.




















If your Sumo Stalk Base is configured for a 270° Rotation follow & +&. Mark out the positions for the Mounting Holes. Please note that your chosen rotate configuration will determine the minimum distance you can mount Sumo from a wall.








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


Drill the mounting holes in your surface using the appropriate Below Surface Mounting Template for your rotate configuration - these guidelines can be found on the previous pages of this booklet.






Attach the socket set-screws into the base of the Sumo Stalk. These screws must be tightened by hand to the full depth of the internal thread - do not over tighten.






Attach the Sumo Stalk to your surface. Tighten the Nyloc Nuts to 4Nm or 2.9 ft-lb. The fixings must be installed in the correct order.






Unpeel the adhesive pads on the Stalk Base and carefully slide the Stalk Cover onto the Stalk Base. Tear off the protective netting. Ensure that the Stalk Cover is securely stuck down.





Locate the Sumo Case onto the Sumo Stalk using the metal locating pins on the Sumo Stalk. Please refer to the guidelines on (42) to correctly configure the case orientation according to your chosen switch configuration.






Follow the guidelines below to correctly orientate your Sumo Case - appropriate to your specified Switch Configuration and chosen Case Orientation.


Hint:

Switch Configuration means whether the Neck of the Stalk allows the screen to rotate from portrait to landscape, or if the screen is locked in a static position.






Secure the Sumo Case onto the Sumo Stalk. Ensure the Case Clamping Plate is orientated correctly - it must sit flush with the case. Tighten the screws (6) to 2Nm or 1.5 ft-lb.






Unlock and remove the Sumo Faceplate.






Feed your tablet cabling through the centre of the case and Case Clamping Plate. Clip the cable into place.



Where the power cable is connected to a power transformer, the cable must be fed from below.



Connect the cable to your tablet and place into the secure case. Your Sumo is configured to house the tablet as specified within your order. If you need to use a different tablet, please contact us.





Attach the Sumo faceplate securely onto the main case body. Press the faceplate onto the case - ensuring all edges are locked securely in place.





Finally, connect your tablet to its power source. You have assembled your Sumo enclosure and it is now ready for use.














If your Sumo Stalk Base is configured for a 180° Rotation follow (65) + (66). Mark out the positions for the Mounting Holes. Please note your chosen rotate configuration will determine the

minimum distance that you can mount Sumo from a wall.



If you wish to insert the tablet cabling through your surface, please mark and drill position **9**.









If your Sumo Stalk Base is configured for a 270° Rotation follow 187 + 188. Mark out the positions for the Mounting Holes. Please note your chosen rotate configuration will determine the

minimum distance that you can mount Sumo from a wall.

If you wish to insert the tablet cabling through your surface, please mark and drill position **3**.






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


If required, drill pilot holes appropriate for your mounting material and screw type. Use the correct template for your rotate configuration - these guidelines can be found on the previous pages.






Feed your tablet cable through the Sumo stalk. Ensure the cable locates and remains within the cable slot in the base.






Attach the Sumo stalk to your mounting surface using five countersunk screws. The screws must not be shorter than 30mm or 1 ¼ inches. For additional security, use anti-tamper screws. They must be screwed flush in the countersunk holes.






Unpeel the adhesive pads on the Stalk Base and carefully slide the Stalk Cover onto the Stalk Base. Tear off the protective netting. Ensure that the Stalk Cover is securely stuck down.





Locate the Sumo Case onto the Sumo Stalk using the metal locating pins on the Sumo Stalk. Please refer to the guidelines on (814) to correctly configure the case orientation according to your chosen switch configuration.






Follow the guidelines below to correctly orientate your Sumo Case - appropriate to your specified Switch Configuration and chosen Case Orientation.




Switch Configuration means whether the Neck of the Stalk allows the screen to rotate from portrait to landscape, or if the screen is locked in a static position.






Feed the tablet cable through the Case Clamping Plate and attach the Sumo case to the Stem. Ensure the metal Case Clamping Plate is orientated correctly - it must sit flush with the case. Tighten the screws to 2Nm or 1.5 ft-lb.






Unlock and remove the Sumo Faceplate.





Connect the cable to your tablet and place into the secure case. Your Sumo case is configured to house the tablet as specified in your order. If you need to use a different tablet, please contact us.
